Time to gather supplies for Personal Care Kits (Heath Kits) for Lutheran World Relief
LWR is running out of Personal Care Kits due to all the problems all over the world. Please help by making the Kits and bringing them to church and leave in the box in the coffee area. We will need the kits turned in **by Sunday, October 28**. If you would like to give money to LWR Quilt & Kit Shipping Fund you can give a check to LWML and designate funds for The Shipping Fund and we will send the money to LWR. Items for kit:

1. light or medium-weight towel (approximately 52" x 27") dark color
2. 2 or 3 bath-size bars (4 to 5 oz total 9 oz) of soap in original wrapping
3. One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging*
4. One sturdy comb, remove packaging
5. One metal nail clippers, remove packaging

*Toothbrush multi-packs may be used by sealing an individual toothbrush in a business-size envelope: no plastic bags or wrap.

Please do not add other items or leave out any of the items listed. All items should be new and in good condition. Wrap all the items in the towel and tie securely with ribbon or yarn. Please do not enclose the kit or any of its contents in plastic bags.
