In March the Columbarium Committee contracted with Eickhof Columbaria for the delivery and installation of a 72-niche granite Columbarium. Each niche has the capacity of two urns which will be supplied with each subscription. It is anticipated that by mid-March the committee will contract for the site preparation located on the west side of the church parking lot directly across from the sanctuary. This facility will be recessed into the berm and be large enough to accommodate future expansion.

We anticipate site construction will start mid-April with completion planned for May 1, 2019. Installation of the Columbarium and its dedication is planned for early July. A subscription packet should be available in April at the Church Office.

In the meantime, questions will be gladly answered by any member of the Columbarium Committee.
