Some General Information About our Columbarium

The Columbarium was dedicated in September 2019. It is located on the west side of our parking lot and is constructed of granite to provide permanent niches for cremains of one or two people.

The Columbarium consists of 72 niches and each will hold two urns.

With a subscription to a niche, you receive the use of the niche, inscriptions on the face plate, two urns and opening and closing of the niche during each interment. In addition you have the privilege to visit the garden at any time.

The Columbarium is equipped with a memorial band for those wishing to list a loved one that may be interred in another cemetery. This band allows one to list the name of the loved one, plus the year of birth and death. This band is near the top of the Columbarium for easy viewing.

We invite you to visit the garden and see for yourself. It is an attractive respectful Christian environment for our members and their families.

To Answer a Few Important FAQ's



How do I subscribe to a niche or memorialize a loved one?

Both transactions are fully explained in our information packet available at the church office.

Can I inter extended family members?

Yes, within limitations as explained in the packet.

What does a niche cost?

Generally less than normally expected and our subscription includes more services and features.

Can I meet with someone that can explain the information in the packet?

After reviewing the packet of information we encourage you to meet with one of the committee members.

Other Useful Information

Administration and governance of the Columbarium will be provided by a committee appointed by the church board. This will include all financial considerations and the enactment, review and compliance to the rules of operation. A complete set of rules will be a part of the packet. These rules will also be a legal part of a niche subscription.

Grace Lutheran Church will be the owner of the garden and its contents. The Church reserves the right to alter, enlarge or move the Columbarium if needed. The Church will provide on going maintenance, keeping the garden clean and presentable at all times.

Any desired action by any subscriber outside the established rules must be approved by the committee in writing.

This new ministry is a way for our church to provide for members and families a permanent resting place. It will connect Grace families to our church for years. Thanks be to God for His continued blessings!
