





## What I learned today:

**Bible: Acts 10:1-44**

Today kids learned about two men who thought they knew everything God wanted them to know. But they found out differently! Cornelius loved God and helped lots of people in need, but he didn't know about Jesus. Peter loved God and loved Jesus but thought Jesus was only for the Jews. Through a vision from God, Peter learned that when Jesus told the disciples to go to "all nations," he meant everyone. So he did what God told him to do—he went and told Cornelius about Jesus. And then both men, Peter and Cornelius, really did know what God wanted them to know.

**Key Verse:** "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19).

**Bible Point:** Tell everyone about Jesus.
