What I Learned Today...

Bible Time: In the Bible passage this week (Acts 10:1-44), Peter leaves his own city and goes to a foreign land to share Jesus' message with Cornelius, a centurion. This was a big change for Peter, who had shared the gospel with Jews only. After a vision from God, though, Peter desired to share the good news about Jesus with everyone—including Gentiles. Most children love to talk about things that are special to them—a special person, toy, or event. During the week, encourage your child to share Jesus by talking about him with everyone he or she meets.

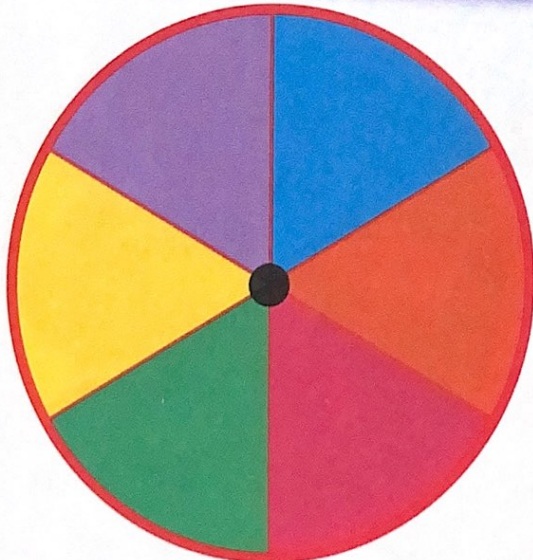
Key Verse: The Holy Spirit will teach you (adapted from John 14:26).

Daily Challenge
